THE RITE WAY!!

Membership development and retention are essential components of Scottish Rite. This Valley has recently adopted some significant programs to implement these goals.

Our Leadership Conference was a smashing success and many great ideas were advanced by those attending. Here is some of what we are doing:

- Blue Lodge Ambassador Program---We are working toward having a Scottish Rite member serve as a Blue Lodge Ambassador to every Blue Lodge in our area. This person will be responsible to the Blue Lodge Ambassador Chairman who will report monthly to the Advisory Conference. Each ambassador will strive to assist the Blue Lodge through a Masonic Education Program and to actively promote Scottish Rite membership in the Blue Lodge.
- 2. VMAP—The Valley Membership Achievement Project is active and starting to blossom. Through its chairman and assistants, VMAP seeks to actively promote the acquisition of new members and the retention of present members. This will include following up on members who might be about to go inactive because of non-payment of dues. When you hear from this committee, step up the plate and take a swing! We need YOU! This Committee will also report monthly to the Advisory Conference.
- 3. Mentoring Program—This Committee is responsible for making sure that every candidate has a mentor assigned BEFORE the Reunion. That mentor is then tasked with two things: (1) contacting the new member each month to make sure that the new member attends the monthly meeting, and (2) that the new member, within sixty days after the Reunion, has a job of some type in Scottish Rite. You will never get more from a person that you expect so set your standards high and empower new members by letting them know that they are NEEDED and WANTED. This program may be expanded in the future to contact inactive members and make them productive members again. We don't need BYSTANDERS, we need MEMBERS!
- 4. Director of the Work—This newly created position is essential. This person is responsible for coordinating with all the degree masters to make sure that the correct degrees are conferred each Reunion; that all degrees are fully staffed; that the degrees are conferred in an effective and powerful way (ever been in a degree when you could not hear a darn word spoken????); and to request each degree team to research their own degree and put together a Masonic education program for that degree which can be shared in the monthly Lodge of Perfection meetings. The Director of the Work will report monthly to a member of the Advisory Conference.

There are lots and lots of other things going on and it is an exciting time to be a Scottish Rite member in Chattanooga! Remember, when you hear the knock, open the door and walk right through! THE BEST IS YET TO COME!!
